05-13-18

- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred between 5/12 10:00pm & 5/13 3:00pm, in the 9500 block of Wendon Street. Someone cut a lock off the door and stole property.
- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred at 3:17am, in the 6200 block of Rosemead Boulevard. Someone shattered a glass door and stole property.

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 10:00am & 1:15pm, in the 5900 block of Reno Avenue. Someone forced entry and stole property.

- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 2:15pm, in the 10600 block of Daines Drive. The suspect was seen on video and by a witness taking a package from a porch.
