

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of July 17, 2018. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of July 17, 2018, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding one item of Conference with Labor Negotiator. There was no reportable action.

At the regular meeting of July 17, 2018, the City Council:

- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of July 3, 2018;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of July 3, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Transportation and Public Safety Commission Meeting on June 13, 2018;
- Received and filed the Actions of the Regular Planning Commission Meeting on June 26, 2018;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5347 reciting the facts of the Special Municipal Election held on June 5, 2018 and declaring such other matters as provided by law for City Measure VP;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5348 changing the reference of Resolution No. 18-5342 pertaining to Appointments to Parks and Recreation Commissioners;
- Approved the Annual Service Agreement with the Temple City Chamber of Commerce covering the term of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, ratified the work that has been done since July 1, 2018, and authorized the City Manager to execute the Annual Service Agreement for Fiscal Year 2018-19;
- Approved a Sister City Partnership Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Temple City and Hualien County, Taiwan;
- Received and filed a visa card report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5349 authorizing the payment of bills for FY 2017-18;
- Adopted Resolution No. 18-5350 authorizing the payment of bills for FY 2018-19;
- Directed staff to bring back a six month trial agreement for a rideshare partnership with Lyft to complement the current Dial-A-Ride program; and
- Disbanded the City Budget Ad Hoc Committee.
