

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of April 2, 2019. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of April 2, 2019, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Employee Performance Evaluation”. City Manager Cook reported out that City Council unanimously offered the position of City Attorney to Assistant City Attorney Greg Murphy and this will be formalized at the next Council meeting;
- Met in Closed Session regarding one item of “Pending Litigation”. There is no reportable action; and
- Meet in Closed Session regarding “Conference with Labor Negotiator”. There is no reportable action.

At the regular meeting of April 2, 2019, the City Council:

- Recognized Deputy of the Year, Deputy Bart Marshall and Firefighter of the Year, Firefighter Specialist Claron McAlister;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of March 19, 2019;
- Received and filed the Regular Planning Commission meeting actions of March 12, 2019;
- Received and filed the Regular Transportation and Public Safety Commission meeting actions of March 13, 2019;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5388 adopting the City’s amended Records Retention Schedule;
- Moved the approval of the first amendment to the Enterprise Vehicle Lease and Maintenance Agreement to the next regular City Council meeting;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5390 authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2018-19;
- Received and filed the updated Pavement Management Program report and directed staff to provide City Council with funding suggestions;
- Authorized staff to negotiate an amended agreement with the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society for animal control, shelter, and licensing services;
- Authorized the City Manager to explore survey services concerning community needs and measures to address fiscal challenges and authorized the City Manager to provide a budget amendment at the next City Council meeting for survey services and supplemental services; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
