

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of May 21, 2019. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of May 21, 2019, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Pending Litigation”. There is no reportable action;
- Meet in Closed Session regarding “Anticipated Litigation”. There is no reportable action;
- Met in Closed Session regarding “Conference with Labor Negotiator”. There is no reportable action;
- Met in Closed Session regarding “Existing Litigation”. There is no reportable action;and
- Met in Closed Session regarding one item of “Potential Litigation”. There is no reportable action.

At the regular meeting of May 21, 2019, the City Council:

- Received a quarterly update from Chamber of Commerce;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 7, 2019;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of May 7, 2019;
- Received and filed a legislative update;
- Approved the Third Amendment to the Consultant Services Agreement with Red 88 Media to video record City Council meetings for live and delayed broadcast to the community and authorized the City Manager to sign the Third Amendment;
- Approved the agreement for Landscape and Grounds Maintenance Services with Los Angeles County and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Approved a three year agreement for generator maintenance and repair services with Affordable Generator Services, Inc. and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Approved a three year agreement for graffiti removal services with Graffiti Control Systems and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Approved the second amendment to the Enterprise Vehicle Lease and Maintenance Agreement and authorized the City Manager to execute the Second Amendment;
- Awarded a three year Agreement for Services to Southland Transit, Inc. for management and operation of the City’s Dial-A-Dial program and authorized the City Manager to finalize and execute the Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$1,599,684 over the three year term;
- Received and filed upcoming outreach opportunities scheduled to solicit input on the Primrose Park design;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 19-5398 authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2018-19;
- Approved a request from the American Cancer Society to co-sponsor the Relay for Life of Temple City at Temple City Park on October 12, 2019 and waived all fees and deposits associated with the installment of a promotional event street banner and use of Temple City Park, the Performing Arts Pavilion, and City hall Community Room for event activities;
- Received updates from the City Manager and City Attorney, and

- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
