05-27-19

- A MW/33 was arrested at 6:45pm for **Residential Burglary & Violation of a Restraining Order**, in the 5500 block of Welland Avenue. The victim had a restraining order against the Suspect (family member), which prohibited him from being near the victim or at the location. The suspect is a family member and a local transient.

05-28-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 8:00am – 2:50pm, in the 5900 block of Rowland Avenue. The victim said someone entered his unlocked residence through a window, but he was unsure if anything was missing at the time. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 3:19pm, in the 4800 block of Rio Hondo Avenue. The victim said someone forcibly entered his residence by shattering the front window, but he was unsure what was missing at the time. There were no reported witnesses.

05-29-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 11:30am – 12:30pm, in the 9600 block of Lemon Avenue. The victim said someone forcibly shattered his rear sliding glass door, and stole his personal property. There was surveillance video depicting a female Black (suspect) initially ringing the victim front doorbell, then three male Blacks (suspects) exiting the victim's backyard and entering a white vehicle.

- A **Grand Theft** occurred on 5/25 between 7:53am – 8:20am, but was reported on 5/30, in the 4900 block of Sereno Drive. The victim said someone stole a package from his front porch. There were no reported witnesses.
