



# CRIME BLOTTER: 06/30/19 – 07/06/19

## 06-30-19

- A **Garage Burglary** occurred between 12:30 – 1:00pm, in the 10300 block of Olive Street. The victim said someone entered his open garage and stole his personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred at 2:02pm, in the 9000 block of Las Tunas Drive. The victim said two male Blacks (suspects) entered the open business and stole her personal property from the office of the location. There was video showing the two suspects entering the location empty handed, then running from the location with the stolen property.
- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 5:00pm – 5:45pm, in the 9900 block of Lower Azusa Road. The victim said someone shattered his vehicle front passenger window and stole his personal property front the front passenger seat. There were no reported witnesses
- An **Assault with a Deadly Weapon** occurred at 6:15pm, in the 6000 block of Kauffman Avenue. The victims said a male Hispanic (suspect) threatened them with a knife and was arrested a short time later. The victims know the suspect. The suspect is resident of Temple City.

- Deputies detained a M/H subject at 2:00am for **Evading a Peace Officer, Driving under the Influence & Unlicensed Driver**, at Lower Azusa Road/Wilmonte Avenue. The subject was driving reckless and refused to stop, when a pursuit was initiated. The subject was taken into custody when he crashed into a fence.
- A **Forgery Grand theft** occurred at 5:28am, in the 4800 block of Cloverly Avenue. The victim said someone accessed his account and obtained a significant amount of his funds.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred between 5/24 – 7/1, in the 9700 block of Olive Street. The victim met the suspect online, and he tricked her out of a large amount of money.

- A **Robbery Strong Armed & Prevent 911 Call** occurred at 8:30am, in the 10100 block of Bogue Street. The victim said the suspect threatened her and took her phone. The victim and suspect know each other. The victim's phone was recovered and the suspect was arrested.

- A **Robbery Strong Armed** occurred at 4:01pm, in the 9500 block of Las Tunas Drive. The victim was entering her vehicle, when she was approached by two female Blacks (suspects), who forcibly took her purse and entered a blue vehicle. There were reported witnesses. The suspects were arrested several days later

The victim said someone forcibly entered his residence by shattering the rear glass door, but he was unsure if anything was missing at the time.
