07-14-19

- A **Petty Theft** occurred between 7/13 8:00pm – 7/14 8:00pm in the 9900 block of Daines Drive. The victim said someone stole items from his shed. There were no reported witnesses.

07-15-19

- A **Vandalism** occurred between 7/14 7:00pm – 7/15 9:00am in the 10700 block of La Rosa Drive. The victim said someone damaged his parked vehicle. There were no reported witnesses
- A **Homicide** occurred at 6:00pm in the 9400 block of Workman Avenue. The victim was shot and succumbed to his injuries. The suspect was arrested at the location, and is a resident of Temple City.

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 7/15 7:00pm – 7/16 7:15am in the 10700 block of Blackley Street. The victim said someone smashed the driver's side window of his parked vehicle and stole his personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
- Deputies arrested a MH/40 at 4:50pm for **Possession of a Controlled Substance** in the 5700 block of Loma Avenue. Deputies contacted the suspect consensually, and discovered he was active parole and possessed suspected narcotics. The suspect is a resident of Los Angeles.

- Deputies arrested a FH/39, MH/37 & MH/23 at 4:40am for **Possession of a Controlled Substance (cocaine & methamphetamine), False identification to a Peace Officer & Drinking Alcohol in a Vehicle**, at Temple City Boulevard/Woodruff Avenue. The suspects were contacted for a vehicle code violation while driving and possessed suspected narcotics, and alcohol inside of a vehicle. One suspect was additionally charged with providing false information. The suspects are residents of Temple City, El Monte, & Baldwin Park.
