02-17-20

- A **Grand Theft, Criminal Conspiracy, & Elder Abuse** occurred on 2/12 12:00pm, but was reported on 2/17, in the 4900 block of Camellia Avenue. The victim said he was exiting his vehicle in his driveway, when a white vehicle (newer model sedan) stopped and the female passenger (suspect) asked him for directions. The victim assisted, when the suspect thanked him with a hug and placed a necklace around his neck, then stole the victim's gold chain without his knowledge. There was a male driver (suspect). There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred at 7:45pm, in the 4900 block of Agnes Avenue. The victim said she was walking, when a newer model silver Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV possible Mercedes) stopped next to her. A female (suspect) exited and approached the victim and tried to sell her a necklace, then placed the necklace around the victim's neck. The victim refused, when the suspect removed the victim's necklace instead and ran back to the SUV. The driver (suspect) was a male. There were no reported witnesses.

- An **Extortion** occurred at 11:00am, in the 9000 block of Rancho Real Road. The victim met a person (suspect) online who deceived him, then threatened him and demanded money. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred between 11:05am – 12:00pm, in the 9500 block of Lemon Avenue. The victim said someone stole her cell phone. There were no reported witnesses.

02-21-20

- Deputies arrested a MA/60 at 9:13am for **Resisting a Peace Officer with Force & Battery on a Peace Officer**, in the 5500 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The suspect was contacted for a theft investigation, when the suspect refused to cooperate and struck the deputy several times.
