## 03-23-20

- Deputies arrested a MB/60 at 10:30am for **Theft by Access Card**, in the 5500 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The victim said he lost his wallet containing his credit cards, when he noticed several unauthorized charges with his credit cards. A male (suspect) found the wallet and used the credit cards to make several unauthorized purchases before being arrested. The suspect is a resident of Pasadena.

- Deputies arrested a MH/33 at 4:42am for **Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia**, at Rosemead Boulevard/Las Tunas Drive.
