04-21-20

- Deputies arrested a MA/33 at 4:00am for **Possession of a Controlled Substance**, in the 5700 block of Cloverly Avenue. The suspect was contacted for a possible domestic dispute. The suspect is resident of Temple City.

- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred at 4:30am, in the 5800 block of Rosemead Blvd. An unknown suspect smashed the front window of the business and stole miscellaneous items. There were no reported witnesses.

- Deputies responded to an **Assault With a Deadly Weapon** call at 3:00pm, in the 4900 block of Halifax Rd. Suspect and victim were family member and had a domestic dispute. The victim succumb to his injuries. The suspect was arrested with no incident.
- A **Robbery** occurred at 8:15pm, in the 9600 block of Longden Avenue. The victim stated he was attempting to purchase the suspect's vehicle which was posted online. The victim met the suspect in front of his house and another person (suspect) came from behind (possibly armed). Suspects demanded all his money and possession. The victim complied with their demands and threw his money and possession in the trunk of the vehicle. The suspects fled northbound on Temple City Blvd and out of view.
