- If you have a witness testifying on your behalf, the witness may be asked to wait in the lobby until called by the Commission.
- Present your case to the Commission. If you are submitting any documents or photographs relevant to your case, they will be retained by the City as part of the official file.
- The Commission will render a decision to uphold or dismiss your citation. A written notification of the Commission's decision will be mailed to you.
- If your citation is upheld, you may appeal the decision of the Commission to the Los Angeles Superior Court – Stanley Mosk Courthouse. You must file your appeal within 35 days from the date the written notification is mailed to you.

The Transportation and Public Safety Commission is requested to recommend that the City Council approve the following traffic measures at the intersection of McCulloch Avenue and Daines Drive:

- a) Install pedestrian signage both approaching and at the crosswalk on Daines Drive;
- b) Replace existing DIP signs at the intersection with pedestrian signs and pavement legends;
- c) Repaint existing crosswalk with white ladder striping and outline in white raised pavement markers for nighttime visibility;
- d) Post a 30 mph speed limit sign on Daines Drive, east of El Monte Avenue for eastbound traffic; and
- e) Direct the City to explore the possibility of adding a street light directly above the existing crosswalk to illuminate it for pedestrians.
