CITY OFFERS EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING

Do you know how to take care of yourself and your family in an emergency? Do you know first aid, search and rescue techniques, and how to suppress a fire? Learn how starting November 5 with free classes offered by the City of Temple City and Los Angeles County Fire Department.

The training covers a series of broad emergency response skills including search and rescue, medical triage and disaster psychology. It also includes a mock disaster drill where teams search for victims in a room with simulated major earthquake damage, using skills learned to evacuate, triage and treat victims for various injuries.

Classes will be held on three consecutive Saturdays (November, 5, 12 and 19) from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Temple City Council Chambers, 5938 Kauffman Ave. Enrollment is open to Temple City residents ages 18 and up.

Those who attend the classes receive Community Emergency Response Training certification. In the event of a disaster, this certification allows the general public to work with city emergency response teams.
