

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of July 21, 2020. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of July 21, 2020, the City Council:

- Received an update from Senator Susan Rubio on state activities and information on housing and homeless issues;
- Approved the minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of July 7, 2020;
- Received and filed the Planning Commission meeting actions of June 23, 2020;
- Authorized the City Manager to execute the Los Angeles County Flood Control District Transfer Agreement for the disbursement of Safe, Clean Water Program funds to the City of Temple City;
- Adopted Resolution 20-5484 authorizing and directing the City Manager to apply for and submit an application for a LEAP grant and if the grant is approved authorizing the City Manager enter into and execute an agreement with the State of California;
- Approved a third amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with R3 Consulting Group, Inc. relating to waste hauling services, authorized the City Manager to sign the third Amendment increasing the contract amount by \$37,001 for a total of \$102,000 and extending the term to June 30, 2021, and approved an appropriation of \$17,001 for Fiscal year 2019-20 for additional services performed;
- Approved plans for the Las Tunas Drive Pavement Rehabilitation Phase 2 from Sultana Avenue to Baldwin Avenue, and authorized staff to advertise the project for bids;
- Adopted resolution authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2019-20;
- Directed City Manager to continue paid administrative leave for the period of August 11, 2020 to September 30, 2020 for all employees except for Senior Recreation Leaders and Recreation Leaders who will be paid for time worked;
- Received an update from City Manager and City Attorney; and
- Received reporting out from Council for items separate from the City Manager's regular agenda.
