

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of October 5, 2021. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special Joint Meeting with Planning Commission on October 5, 2021, the City Council and Planning Commission:

- Reviewed, received, and discussed next steps in addressing changes made by Senate Bill 9 (Urban Lot Splits).

At the Regular meeting of October 5, 2021, the City Council:

- Received an update on current water supply condition from Upper San Gabriel Valley Municipal Water District;
- Approved Minutes of the Special and Regular City Council Meeting of September 21, 2021;
- Approved an extension of the City of Temple City Emergency Paid Sick Leave (TCEPSL) policy, Administrative Policy Number 4.19, to January 31, 2022 for COVID-19 related absences and authorized the City Manager to sign Revision Number 1 of the TCEPSL policy;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5559 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2020-21;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5560 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-22;
- Introduced for first reading by title only and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 21-1057, amending Title 2, Chapter 6, Article C, Section 5 of the Temple City Municipal Code regarding the Art in Public Places Program and scheduled the second reading of Ordinance No. 21-1057 for October 19, 2021;
- Reviewed the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Fourth Quarter Financial Review and related reports and approved and authorized staff to review revenue and expenditure estimates as indicated in staff report Attachment A;
- Directed staff to bring back the discussion for potential uses of the American Rescue Plan Act allocation allocated to the City of Temple City totaling \$8,566,752;
- Held a discussion and directed staff to bring back a resolution with staff's recommendation on the appropriation of the Permanent Local Housing Allocation funding;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
