

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of November 16, 2021. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Regular meeting of November 16, 2021, the City Council:

- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of November 2, 2021;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5565, adopting salary ranges for unrepresented part-time classifications implementing the minimum wage effective on January 1, 2022 and approved a Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget amendment of \$20,100 for the additional fiscal impact in the General Fund Parks and Recreation Department, #01-940;
- Authorized the City Manager to sign and execute Amendment No. 1 to the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) (Attachment "A") with the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments (SGVCOG) for participation in the San Gabriel Valley Regional Food Recovery Program;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5569 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-22;
- Relaxed overnight parking enforcement from 12:00 midnight on Sunday, December 19, 2021 to 11:59 p.m. on Monday, January 3, 2022;
- Received the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 (FY21-22) First Quarter Financial Review and related reports, and approved and authorize staff to revise revenue estimates as indicated in Attachment A;
- Approved the public art recommendation concepts for five locations, allocated Art in Public Places funds not to exceed \$50,000, and for the artist who will be retained for the murals and sculptures to create an artist rendering/examples for Council approval at a future meeting;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5567 to allow City Council to continue the use of teleconferencing or videoconferencing for Brown Act-covered public meetings of the City Council and City commissions for a period of 30 days (i.e., December 18, 2021);
- Provided staff feedback regarding the Community Development Block Grant Programs for Fiscal Year 2022-2023;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
