

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of June 8, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meetings. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meetings.

At the Special meeting of June 8, 2022, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session for a Conference with Labor Negotiator. There is no reportable action; and
- Met in Closed Session for Conference with Legal Counsel regarding an anticipated litigation. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of June 8, 2022, the City Council:

- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of May 17, 2022;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 17, 2022;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Budget Study Session Meeting of May 27, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Planning Commission Regular Meeting of May 10, 2022;
- Approved a new agreement between the City of Temple City and the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society for animal control, shelter, and license services for Fiscal Year 2022-23 and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Approved Resolution 22-5597 to approve the resurfacing of various streets citywide as Temple City's designated project for Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds for Fiscal Year 2022-23 pursuant to Senate Bill 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, directed the City Manager to include the corresponding Capital Improvement Projects in the FY 2022-23 City Budget including RMRA funds and the required General Fund maintenance of effort match, and authorized the City Manager to submit the required documents and information to the California Transportation Commission for the City to receive RMRA funds;
- Approved a 6.0% rate adjustment for solid waste collection services by Athens to become effective July 1, 2022;
- Approved a Memorandum of Understanding between the Cities of Temple City and El Monte for the Baldwin Avenue and El Monte Avenue Rehabilitation Project, and allocate \$35,805 from Proposition C Funds to cover the City of Temple City's share of costs for the project;
- Approved the First Amendment to the Consultant Services Agreement with Red 88 Media to add additional "on call" services to the agreement and authorized the City Manager to sign the First Amendment to the Agreement;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5600 to authorize the use of technology for teleconferencing or videoconferencing of Brown Act-covered public meetings of the City Council and City;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5599 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-22;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5598 ordering the levy and collection of assessments for Fiscal Year 2022-2023;
- Introduced Ordinance No. 22-1063 for first reading by title only, changing the reference number of Ordinance No. 22-1060 to 22-1063 pertaining to Campaign Contribution Limits, waived further reading of Ordinance No. 22-1063, and scheduled the second reading of Ordinance No. 22-1063 for June 21, 2022;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
