

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of July 5, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meetings. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meetings.

At the Special meeting of July 5, 2022, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session for Conference with Labor Negotiator. There is no reportable action; and
- Met in Closed Session for Conference with Legal Counsel regarding an anticipated litigation. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of July 5, 2022, the City Council:

- Adopted resolutions confirming the appointments of Tom O'Leary and Serge Haddad to the Planning Commission; Kristel Haddad and Jose Tarin to the Parks and Recreation Commission, and Ousama Nimri and Sunny Lo to the Transportation and Public Safety Commission, for a term of two years from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2024;
- Proclaimed July as Parks and Recreation Month;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of June 21, 2022; Special City Council Closed Session meeting of June 21, 2022; and Special City Council Meeting for Transportation and Public Safety Commissioner interviews of June 21, 2022;
- Approved Amendment No. 5 to the Support Services Agreement for information technology with City of Brea/BreaIT;
- Reviewed and approved the First Amendment to the consultant services agreement with Sandra Medrano (Medrano) to provide housing consultant services for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23 and increase the total compensation by \$34,495, for a total of \$108,295 and authorized the City Manager to finalize and execute the First Amendment with Medrano for FY 2022-23;
- Received and filed the Third Quarter Fiscal Year 2021-22 (i.e., July 2021 to March 2022) Financial Status Report and related reports and approved and authorized staff to revise revenue and expenditure budget estimates as indicated in Attachment "A";
- Approved a three-year Agreement with Gerald A. Jambazian for a total amount of \$15,900 from July 5, 2022 through July 5, 2025, approved a budget amendment of \$5,300 for Fiscal Year 2022-23 to the City Manager's Special Contract Services account, and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5609 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-2022;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5610 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Approved the Minutes of the Successor Agency to the former Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency meeting of May 3, 2022;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5611-SA approving Successor Agency payment of bills for FY 2021-22;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
