

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of July 19, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meetings. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meetings.

At the Regular meeting of July 19, 2022, the City Council:

- Presented certificate of recognition to Dr. Jack Von Bulow, DDS congratulating him on his retirement and providing service to the community for over 35 years;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of July 5, 2022;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of July 5, 2022;
- Approved hosting and co-sponsorship of a 2022 Hi Autumn Festival (Festival) with World Journal LA, LLC (World Journal) on Saturday, September 10 through Sunday, September 11, 2022; waived all fees and deposits for use of Temple City Park and the Performing Arts Pavilion; waived all fees and authorize City staff to hang a street banner on Las Tunas Drive from August 8 to September 11, 2022; approved the use of the City Seal and City Logo for advertising and promotional materials; granted World Journal LA, LLC a special event permit with the conditions and responsibilities stated in the staff report; and authorized the City Manager to place additional conditions if necessary;
- Received and filed the Planning Commission Actions for the Meeting of June 14, 2022;
- Received and filed the Parks and Recreation Commission Actions for the Meeting of June 15, 2022;
- Received and filed the Transportation and Public Safety Commission Actions for the Meeting of June 22, 2022;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5612 to allow City Council meetings to be held remotely, for a period of 30 days, consistent with Assembly Bill 361;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5613 for 6 full-time unrepresented classifications approving the salary ranges and benefits and appropriated a total of \$62,985 from the reserves of the affected funds for Fiscal Year 2022-2023;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5616 approving the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Temple City (City) and the Temple City Employees Association (TCEA), approved the revised salary schedule for the TCEA represented classifications and its corresponding part-time positions, and appropriated a total of \$173,210 from the reserves of the affected funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2023;
- Received and filed the Petty Cash Report;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5614 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-2022;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5615 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Approved adjustment to Council compensation from \$720 to \$1,080 per month as allowed by Government Code Section 36516.5 effective March 6, 2024;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
