

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of October 4, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Regular meeting of October 4, 2022, the City Council:

- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of September 14, 2022;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of September 20, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Planning Commission Regular Meeting of September 13, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Transportation and Public Safety Commission Regular Meeting of September 14, 2022;
- Authorized City Manager to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), once reviewed and approved as to form by City Attorney, with El Monte City School District (EMCSD) for funding students at Cleminson School to participate in the City's STARS Club;
- Authorized the City Manager to sign and execute the Second Amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments (SGVCOG) for participation in the San Gabriel Valley Regional Food Recovery Program;
- Authorized staff to advertise a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the development of design plans and construction documents for the playground renovations at Live Oak Park and Temple City Park with removal of Evaluation Criteria Item 5 as the city will be evaluating bidders based on their professional service;
- Authorized Bidding and Contract Documents, Plans and Specifications and authorization to invite bids for City Hall Trellis Replacement Project, Capital Improvement Project (CIP No. P23-07);
- Received and filed the Petty Cash Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5633 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Approved the Third Amendment to the City Manager's Employment Agreement and approved the cost of living adjustment in the Third Amendment, appropriating a total of \$14,495 from the reserves of the General Fund for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Approved a budget increase in the supplemental law enforcement services by \$75,000 from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and approved a budget amendment for the same amount in the General Fund;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
