

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of October 18, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Regular meeting of October 18, 2022, the City Council:

- Proclaimed October 22, 2022 Paint the Town Purple Day;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of October 4, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Planning Commission Regular Meeting of September 27, 2022;
- Adopted resolution to approve Environmentally Preferable Purchasing and Practices Policy in accordance with the CalRecycle Rubberized Pavement Grant Program and authorized the City Manager to submit CalRecycle grant funding request application for FY 2022-23 and take all actions necessary;
- Accepted project completion for the Primrose Park Project, CIP No. P21-01 as performed by CEM Construction Corp for a total amount of \$2,717,096.25; authorized the City Manager to file a project Notice of Completion with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder; and authorized the City Manager to release a retention payment of \$135,854.81 to CEM Construction Corp within 35 days following recordation of the Notice of Completion;
- Reviewed use of teleconferencing or videoconferencing for Brown Act-covered public meetings of the City Council and City commissions and adopted Resolution No. 22-5636 to authorize the use of such technology for meetings for a period of 30 days;
- Approved the temporary street and lane closures on Las Tunas Drive between Muscatel Avenue and Baldwin Avenue on November 5, 2022, from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. for the Run Away From Drugs Run/Walk;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5637 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Adopted a resolution approving the addendum (Attachment “B”) to the Mid-Century General Plan EIR; amended the General Plan by adopting the proposed Housing Element 2021-2029 (Attachment “C”) to replace the current Housing Element 2013-2021; and authorized the City Manager, or designee, to make technical changes and other non-substantive edits that may result from the review of the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) without further consideration or re-adoption by the City Council;
- Approved a Consultant Services Agreement with Red 88 Media for “Design and Installation” services for the Council Chamber and Council Chambers computer room equipment upgrade in an amount not to exceed \$24,900; authorized the City Manager to sign the Consultant Services Agreement with Red 88 Media; approved the purchase of equipment to upgrade and enhance the quality of audio and video in the Council Chambers and Council Chambers Computer Room (i.e., for live, live streaming, and virtual participation of meeting) in an amount not to exceed \$74,500.00 (Attachment “B”); and approved a total expenditure budget amendment of \$99,400 from the Unassigned General Fund;
- Received an update regarding current citation process for “no front license plate” violations and directed staff to highlight or make more visible the process for correctable violations such as missing front license plate;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
