

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of November 15, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special meeting of November 15, 2022, the City Council:

- Met regarding one item of Anticipated Litigation. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of November 15, 2022, the City Council:

- Received an update from the Youth Committee;
- Received an update from the Chamber of Commerce;
- Approved the City Council Regular Meeting Minutes of November 1, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Transportation and Public Safety Commission Meetings of September 28 and October 12, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Parks and Recreation Commission Meetings of October 19, 2022;
- Approved the Agreement for Services with Michael Baker International Inc. to conduct California Environmental Quality Act analysis for a subdivision of 23 lots at 6355, 6362, and 6415 Oak Avenue; and authorized the City Manager to execute the Agreement for Services with Michael Baker for an amount not to exceed \$247,530.80;
- Approved a request from the Temple City Camellia Festival for support and authorization for use of streets and facilities for the 2023 Camellia Festival;
- Awarded a Public Works Contracts to Concept Consultant, Inc. for City Hall Trellis Replacement Project, Capital Improvement Project (CIP No. P23-07);
- Adopted a resolution to allow City Council meetings to be held remotely pursuant to AB 361;
- Relaxed overnight parking enforcement from 12:00 midnight on Sunday, December 18, 2022, to 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, January 3, 2023;
- Received and filed the Petty Cash Report;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5640 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Read by title only and waived further reading of Ordinance 22-1066 adopting by reference and amending the 2023 Los Angeles County Building, Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical, Residential and Existing Building Codes, 2022 California Green Building Standards Code and adding a new Chapter 10 Electric Vehicle Charging Stations;
- Continued the public hearing for the establishment of an expedited, non-discretionary multi-family review process and a library of prototype architectural designs for multi-family projects to the meeting on December 6, 2022;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
