

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of March 7, 2023. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Regular meeting of March 7, 2023, the City Council:

- Reorganized and seated Mayor Man and Mayor Pro Tem Chavez:
- Approved the City Council Meeting Minutes of February 21 and February 22, 2023 and Regular Meeting Minutes of February 21, 2023 and found that the City Council Minutes is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Received and filed the Planning Commission Actions of January 24, 2023 and found that the Commission Actions is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Approve the temporary street closure on Broadway between Muscatel Avenue and Cloverly Avenue on March 25, 2023, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for the Archdiocesan Eucharistic Procession and found that approval of the temporary street closure is not a "Project" as defined under Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act State Guidelines; therefore, pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3) no environmental review is required;
- Authorized the City Clerk to certify Tract Map No. 82843 found that approval of the subdivision map is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Adopted Ordinance No. 23-1069 updating Title 9 of the Temple City Municipal Code and waived further reading, adopted Resolution No. 23-5653 amending the General Plan Land Use Element to clarify Mixed-Use and Residential Densities, and found that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to Section 15061 (b)(3) and 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5659 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
