3. PL 23-4250 A request to modify an approved conditional use permit to increase the amount of food and drink establishments in the Camellia Square shopping center. The shopping center currently has a limit of 27,345 square feet of food and drink establishments. The owner is requesting to increase the limit by approximately 3,300 square feet, which would result in a new limit of 30,645 square feet of food and drink establishments for the shopping center.
